- IWU INTRAMURAL AND CLUB SPORTS programs include badminton, basketball, cheerleading, dance team, soccer, softball, Tae Kwon Do, volleyball, yoga, and more.
- IWU STUDENT WELLNESS offers a variety of fitness-oriented classes such as aerobics, Pilates, spinning, WERQ, yoga, and zumba.

THE COMMUNITY OF Bloomington-Normal OFFERS an array of opportunities for athletic and recreational activities:

- PEPSI ICE CENTER provides ice time for hockey and skating year-round.
- UPPER LIMITS Rock Gym and Pro Shop, among the largest climbing gyms in North America, features more than 20,000 square feet of climbing surface, a 110-foot outdoor wall, and even ice climbing on an artificial frozen waterfall during the winter months.
- CONSTITUTION TRAIL features more than 37 miles of paved trail through both forested and commercial areas of the Twin Cities. The trail is perfect for runners, cyclists, and in-line skaters, and is accessible just a few blocks from the Shirk Athletic Center.
